

Environmental policy

LMC Group Ltd Directors make every effort (where possible) to ensure any materials that we source and use on behalf of either ourselves or our clients, either directly or through third party suppliers, should be sustainable, re-usable or recyclable.

We recognise that we have an important part to play in the reduction of waste, degradation of the natural environment and over exploitation of natural resources and when necessary, will dispose of materials that are not as above in a responsible manner that abides with the necessary regulations.

This policy is maintained by following these four steps.

1. Responsibility for ensuring environmental and corporate responsibility will be assigned to a Director of the Company.
2. To establish procedures for the implementation and monitoring of environmental and corporate responsibility policies.
3. To establish an ongoing and regular review of these policies.
4. The company will communicate any policy changes to staff, suppliers and clients.

Procedures

For clients we will recommend and apply our policy wherever possible and take into account the environmental concerns of our clients, including the use of suitable materials (as above) whilst still maintaining the quality of build for which LMC Group Office Ltd is renowned.

We check whether our suppliers are using recyclable materials (such as paper and packaging), sustainable timber sources, bio-degradable materials or returnable materials. Their response is considered when selecting suppliers, subcontractors or third parties.

For our staff we ask them to abide by this policy of supplier selection during the consideration of contracts, and to make our policy freely available to clients and suppliers.

We are proud of our policy and encourage our partners, clients and suppliers to adopt a similar philosophy; we shall communicate any changes to them, as appropriate.
